



TAKEOFF MINIMUMS

Rwy 2: Standard.

Rwy 20: 400-23/4 or standard with minimum climb of 205' per NM to 1300, or alternatively, with standard takeoff minimums and a normal 200' per NM climb gradient, takeoff must occur no later than 1200' prior to DER.

. . . . on RADAR vectors to LAMDE, then on depicted route to LILLS. Maintain 3000. Expect clearance to filed altitude within 10 minutes after departure.
