- Intermediate Approach:** 4 NM hold at 6000 ft, 2600 ft, 168° heading. Then 348° to 2600 NoPT, 258° to (5) (IAF) JUPSI.
- Final Approach:** 2600 NoPT, 078° to (5) (IAF) WIDUR. Then 348° to 2100 ft, 168° to (IF/IAF) HOOTs. Then 2100 ft, 168° to (FAF) HARNN. Then 728 ft, 168° to MUFFN (1.7 NM to RW17). Then 728 ft, 168° to RW17 (579± ft).
- Other Features:** COLUMBUS 1 MOA, WIDUR, JUPSI, MUFFN, RW17, and various altitudes (2600, 6000, 2100, 728, 579±).
