

TOP ALTITUDE: ASSIGNED BY ATC



TAKEOFF MINIMUMS:

Rwy 10: Standard.

Rwy 28: 200-11/4 or standard with minimum climb of 235' per NM to 700, or alternatively, with standard takeoff minimums and a normal 200' per NM climb gradient, takeoff must occur

no later than 1900' prior to DER.

NOTE: RADAR and GPS required.

NOTE: RNAV 1.

NOTE: Do not exceed 250K until advised by ATC.

NOTE: For prop aircraft during Masters golf tournament week only.

DEPARTURE ROUTE DESCRIPTION

TAKEOFF RWY 10, 28: Climb on assigned heading for RADAR vectors to PMPAS. Then on depicted route to NDINA, then fly heading 273°, for RADAR vectors. . . .

.... maintain altitude assigned by ATC. Expect clearance to filed altitude/flight level within 10 minutes after departure.
