
BNDIA THREE DEPARTURE (RNAV)

DEPARTURE ROUTE DESCRIPTION

<u>TAKEOFF RUNWAY 8</u>: Climb on heading 081° or as assigned by ATC for vectors to cross GARDS at or above 5000, thence....

<u>TAKEOFF RUNWAY 13:</u> Climb on heading 126° or as assigned by ATC for vectors to cross GARDS at or above 5000, thence....

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 17: Climb on heading 171° or as assigned by ATC for vectors to cross GARDS at or above 5000, thence....

<u>TAKEOFF RUNWAY 26</u>: Climb on heading 261° or as assigned by ATC for vectors to cross GARDS at or above 5000, thence....

<u>TAKEOFF RUNWAY 31</u>: Climb on heading 306° or as assigned by ATC for vectors to cross GARDS at or above 5000, thence....

<u>TAKEOFF RUNWAY 35</u>: Climb on heading 351° or as assigned by ATC for vectors to cross GARDS at or above 5000, thence....

....on track 224° to BNDIA. Maintain altitude assigned by ATC. Expect filed altitude 10 minutes after departure.
