- Final Approach:** 2600 NoPT, 078° heading, (5) minutes to WIDUR (IAF). Then 2100 ft, 168° heading, (6.1) minutes to HARNN (FAF). Then 728 ft, 1.7 NM to RW17, 579± ft.
