TAKEOFF MINIMUMS

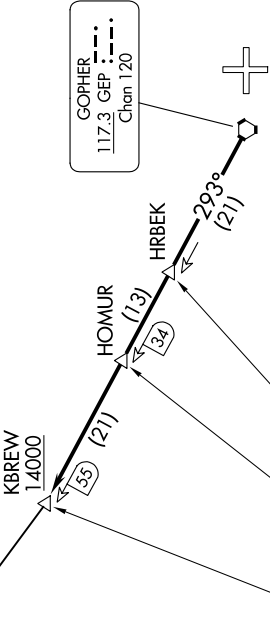
- Rwy 9: Standard with a minimum climb of 341' /NM to 3000.
- Rwy 18: Standard with a minimum climb of 370' /NM to 3000.
- Rwy 27: Standard with a minimum climb of 259' /NM to 2800.
- Rwy 36: Standard with a minimum climb of 259' /NM to 2800.

DEPARTURE ROUTE DESCRIPTION

TAKEOFF ALL RUNWAYS: Climb on assigned heading for RADAR vectors to GEP VORTAC then on depicted route to KBREW, thence. . . .on transition. Maintain ATC assigned altitude. Expect filed altitude 10 minutes after departure.

FARGO TRANSITION (KBREW2.FAR): From over KBREW on FAR R-116 to FAR VOR/DME.
