Thank you for your letter dated October 25, 2018, in response to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) letter of October 1, 2018, concerning the assessment of effects on historic properties and proposed finding under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act for the above-referenced matter. The FAA acknowledges that the California Office of Historic Preservation (SHPO) cannot concur with our proposed finding, as it believes our efforts to identify historic properties are incomplete.


The SHPO response to our letter of September 18, 2018, of the FAA's request for assistance in identifying parties who might have an interest in commenting on the FAA's proposal, was received October 4, 2018. It is evident that we did not allow sufficient time for the SHPO to process our inquiry and respond accordingly.

In light of the considerations noted in your letter of October 25, 2018, the FAA shall seek and consider the views of the identified entities in an effort to complete a reasonable and good faith effort to identify historic properties, as outline at 800.4(b)(1) of 36 CFR 800, *Protection of Historic Properties*.

Thank you for your assistance in identifying other interested parties. The FAA is currently in the process of reaching out to these parties to request assistance in identifying historic properties where a quiet setting is a contributing factor to the property's historic significance.
