# Project Background and Purpose

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) implemented the current OROSZ and SLAPP departure routes for the Hollywood Burbank (BUR) Airport in March 2017.

They were part of the FAA's Southern California Metroplex project, which included dozens of satellite-based arrival and departure routes for airports throughout the region.

The FAA is proposing to amend the OROSZ and SLAPP departure routes.

The proposed amendments will fulfill the terms of a Settlement Agreement between the FAA, Benedict Hills Estates Association and Benedict Hills Homeowners Association, and will continue to provide safe and efficient operations at Hollywood Burbank Airport and the surrounding airspace.



# FAA Roles and Responsibilities


- The FAA is the agency of the United States Department of Transportation responsible for the regulation and oversight of civil aviation within the U.S., as well as operation and development of the National Airspace System.
- The FAA's primary mission is to provide the safest, most efficient aerospace system in the world.
- The FAA does not have the authority to direct or influence commercial air carriers to provide services at a particular airport or to require them to shift services from one airport to another.
- The FAA and Airport Owner/Operator do not dictate what aircraft use an airport. Public use airports such as Hollywood Burbank Airport cannot deny an aircraft operator if they request to operate to/from that airport.



# Hollywood Burbank Airport Air Carrier Operations

- Air carrier operations at Burbank have increased during the past several years. There were approximately 40 percent more air carrier operations in August 2018 compared to January 2016.
- The FAA does not have the authority to direct or influence commercial service providers to provide commercial air carrier services at a particular airport or to require them to shift services from one airport to another.
