

FAA PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is proposing improvements to air traffic procedures in the Las Vegas metropolitan area that will make the airspace more efficient and help reduce delays.

The improvements are part of the FAA's efforts to modernize the National Airspace System through the use of satellite-based navigation as part of the Next Generation Air Transportation System, more commonly known as NextGen.

The FAA has identified multiple Metroplex areas in the United States. Each Metroplex includes one or more commercial airports that serve at least one major city. A Metroplex allows the FAA to improve regional traffic movement by making the best use of airspace and procedures, using precise, satellite-based navigation. The use of NextGen procedures in these areas could improve on-time performance, which would benefit the region and the entire national airspace system. For more information, please see our website:
