Dear Participant,

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has scheduled the 26-02 Aeronautical Charting Meeting (ACM) for **Monday, September 21**, through **Wednesday, September 23, 2026**.

The Charting Group (CG) meeting is scheduled for two days, and will meet from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on **Monday, September 21**, and **Tuesday, September 22**. The Instrument Procedures Group (IPG) meeting will meet from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on **Wednesday, September 23**. All times are Eastern Time.

The meeting will be held virtually via Zoom, with an in-person option for FAA personnel. Details regarding how to participate in the meeting will be provided via email to those on our email distribution list. To be added to the email list, send a message with your contact information to 9-amc-avs-acm-info@faa.gov.

The purpose of the ACM is threefold:

- 1) Identify issues concerning the safety and usefulness of aeronautical charts and flight information products/services.
- 2) Discuss and evaluate proposals concerning publicly available aeronautical charts and flight information publications, digital aeronautical products, database coding, instrument flight procedures, and instrument flight procedure development, policy, and design.
- 3) Provide an opportunity for government and interested participants to brief and/or discuss new navigation concepts, terminal instrument procedures (TERPS) policy/criteria changes, and charting specifications and methodologies.

The meeting will be a facilitated discussion of new and outstanding topics. The status of an open issue will be reported from meeting to meeting until a resolution is reached, at which point the issue will be closed.
