# Initiative

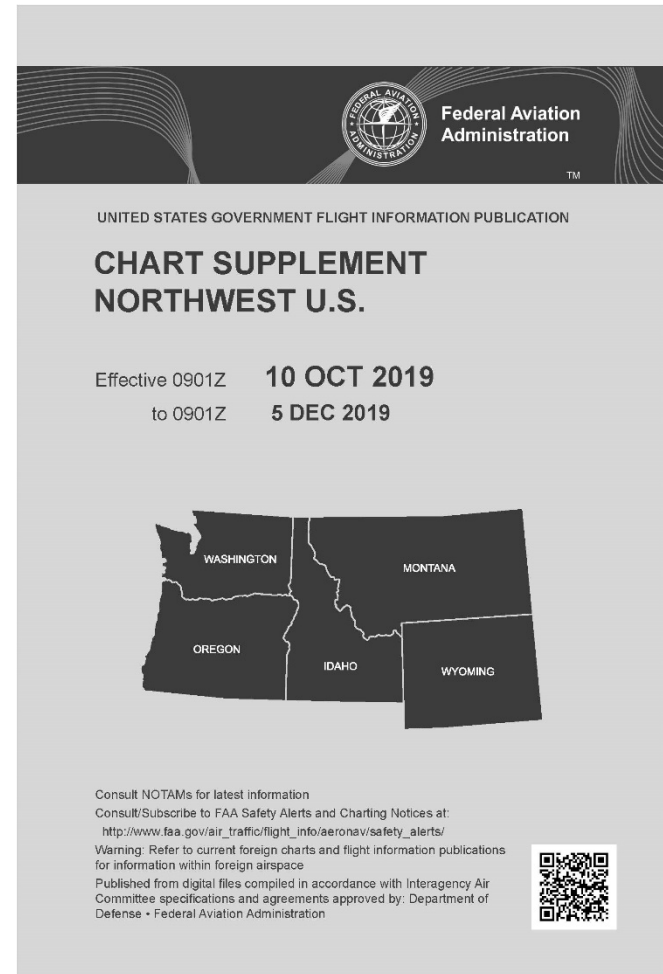
- **NOTAMs should only be published on the Federal NOTAM System (FNS)**
- **Aeronautical Information should reside in an authoritative source and not be published by the agency in multiple venues**



# Chart Supplement Purpose

This Chart Supplement is a Civil Flight Information Publication updated every eight weeks by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, Aeronautical Information Services, <http://www.faa.gov/go/ais>. *It is designed for use with Aeronautical Charts .....*

**Items in the Chart Supplement will comply within the scope of the product definition.**



# Chart Supplement Back matter (Sections 3 and above)

Excluding Airport Diagrams, almost 1100 pages of miscellaneous information comprising of 23 sections, 84 categories, and 75 sub-categories.

# What will be happening?

- **Only sourced and verified information will reside in the chart supplement\***
- **Duplicative and unverified information will be removed from the chart supplement**
- **Only information within the scope of the chart supplement will reside in the chart supplement**

**\*FAA Information published in another FAA product will not be published in the Chart Supplement**



# To-be state

- **Working group to be stood-up to help determine what categories fall within the scope of the chart supplement**
- **New specifications created for all future entries**
- **Chart supplement will be reformatted**
