Subject: Discontinuance of the FAACIFP15 and FAACIFP13 Specifications

To users of the Coded Instrument Flight Procedures (CIFP):

Effective with the January 3, 2019 AIRAC Cycle, the Federal Aviation Administration, Aeronautical Information Services is considering terminating the dissemination of CIFP files FAACIFP15 and FAACIFP13. These databases conform to ARINC Specification 424-15 and 424-13 Navigation Systems Data Base, respectively.

Customers will still be able to obtain the same (if not more detailed) information in the file FAACIFP18 which will continue to be provided to CIFP subscribers. This file conforms primarily to the ARINC 424-18 Specifications.

This is being done in order to reduce the time and cost needed to maintain the CIFP and allow us to use resources to support new digital aeronautical products for our customers, as well as important FAA Next Generation Air Transportation System (NextGen) initiatives.
