Subject: Changes to the Chart Supplement Alaska to comply with updated Interagency Air Cartographic Committee (IACC) 8 Specifications and to support data content automation.

The FAA/ Aeronautical Information Services will implement updated IACC 8 Specifications (specs) starting with the 26 May 2016 edition of the Chart Supplement Alaska. Also, with the automation of data entry to digital content of the book, some features of the book have changed as listed below:

- The Table of Contents was revised and re-organized to comply with the updated IACC 8 Specifications.
- The index tabs were removed (from the table of contents (TOC) page and from the internal pages) and the TOC was formatted to comply with the IACC 8 specs and to match the other chart supplements.
- A City/Military Airport Cross Reference section was added to the book and the TOC.
- A Seaplane Landing Areas section was added to the book and the TOC.
- The Canadian airports and NAVAIDs are now contained in a separate section.
- The Canadian Section was added to the TOC.
- The back-matter sections were re-organized and the TOC updated to match the new order and comply with the IACC 8 specs.
- The internal TOC pages (there used to be a separate internal TOC page for the Associated Data section and the Procedures section) were removed and the contents added to the main TOC in the front of the book.
- The TOC section is now completely automated and the TOC entries are hypertext links to the contents of the book in the PDF file version.
- The index at the back of the book has been removed.
- The final PDF file now contains PDF bookmarks for added functionality.
- The ARTCC and FSS information has been moved from the A/FD section to separate sections in the back-matter.
