Subject: Discontinuing CIFP Versions 15 and 13

The Federal Aviation Administration, Aeronautical Navigation products is **considering discontinuing** the older versions of the Coded Instrument Flight Procedure (CIFP) files:

FAACIFP15 and FAACIFP13.

These two files conform to ARINC Navigation System Data Base (NDB) Specification versions 424-15 and 424-13 respectively.

Customers will still be able to obtain the same, as well as more detailed, information within the FAACIFP18 files which will continue to be provided to CIFP subscribers. This file follows the ARINC 424-18 specification with minor enhancements described in the CIFP ReadMe file.

Discontinuing the older ARINC 424 versions will allow Aeronautical Navigation Products to focus resources on continued evolution of newer ARINC 424 versions; create new digital aeronautical products; and support FAA Next Generation Air Transportation System (NexGen) initiatives.
