To All Digital En Route Supplement (DERS) Customers:

As a part of the Federal Aviation Administration consolidating processes and eliminating redundancies, Aeronautical Information Services is eliminating Standard Terminal Arrival Routes (STARs) and Standard Instrument Departure (SIDs) routes from the Digital En Route Supplement (DERS) after the 10 December 2015 effective date.

The files to be eliminated within the product are DP.DAT and STARS.DAT.

Similar information can be found within the Coded Instrument Flight Procedures (CIFP) via <http://www.faa.gov/go/ais>. The CIFP does not currently contain all published SID and STAR information. However, Aeronautical Information Services is targeting complete SID and STAR information inclusion for the CIFP within one year after DPs and STARs are removed from the DERS.
