Subject: d-TPP volumes that contain georeferenced digital files

In certain volumes of the digital-Terminal Procedures Publication (d-TPP) the FAA maintained Instrument Approach Procedure charts published in PDF format now carry georeferenced encoding for geographic positioning. Coordinate readings are based on a Lambert Conformal Conic projection, NAD83 Datum, and GRS 1980 Ellipsoid. The georeferenced encoding is only valid within the Planview portion of the chart.
