Subject: FAA Airport Location Identifier vs ICAO Location Indicator in Index (Revised)

FAA Airport Location Identifier vs ICAO Location Indicator in Index (Revised-Effective June 15, 2023)

Beginning with the June 15, 2023 effective date, a temporary fix will be implemented that will update the indexes of these volumes of the US Terminal Procedures Publications with the following:

AK All airports, civil and military, will show (FAA airport location identifier/ICAO location indicator)

PAC All airports will show (FAA airport location identifier/ICAO location indicator)

SE-3 All Caribbean airports will show (FAA airport location identifier/ICAO location indicator). All military airports will show (ICAO location indicator). All Florida civil airports will show (FAA airport location identifier)

Civil airports will show (FAA airport location identifier)

Military airports will show (ICAO location indicator)

**FAA Airport Location Identifier vs ICAO Location Indicator in Index
(Original Notice-Effective April 20, 2023)**

Beginning with the April 20, 2023 effective date, the index in the front of the US Terminal Procedures Publications (excluding the AK volume) will show the 3-letter FAA airport identifier instead of the 4-letter ICAO airport identifier for military installations.

This change was implemented as part of an ongoing process to standardize the data prior to a complete technical refresh of the production database. The estimated completion of the technical refresh is September 2024. At that time, the index will show the 4-letter ICAO for military installations.

This change only affects the index in the ready-for-print version of the US Terminal Procedures Publications. It does not affect the digital-Terminal Procedures Publications (xml) available on our website here:
