

Subject: Introduction of Caribbean VFR Aeronautical Chart Series

### Caribbean VFR Aeronautical Charts (CAC)

This notice serves as the introduction of the new Caribbean VFR Aeronautical Charts. Caribbean 1 and Caribbean 2 (CAC-1 and CAC-2) are being created to supplant the discontinuance of World Aeronautical Charts CJ-26 and CJ-27, respectively. The purpose of these charts is to expand and maintain continuous VFR chart coverage in the Caribbean (Bahamas, Greater Antilles and northern islands of the Lesser Antilles.) In use, the charts will be similar to the World Aeronautical Charts. The charts are designed for VFR flight and provide aeronautical and topographic information

The CAC-1 and CAC-2 are scheduled for publication effective 15 SEP 2016 and 10 NOV 2016, respectively. CAC-1 consists of two sides measuring 30" x 60" each. CAC-2 consists of two sides measuring 20" x 60" each. Both charts will be available in digital raster PDF and GeoTIFF formats.



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
