Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Flight Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Before using international airports, operators are required to obtain an in depth briefing from the Civil Aviation Authorities of the applicable Emirate.

No aircraft constructed in Israel will be allowed to service, refuel or land at any airport or aerodrome within the Emirates FIR.

Minimum insurance requirements apply to all civil registered aircraft; a copy of insurance certificate is required.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

- → General Declaration
- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at <u>IFIM Home>General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents</u>. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an eAPIS manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

Emirate of Abu Dhabi

- → Valid Passport
- → Persons may be issued a transit visa for 72 hours only. Longer than 72 hours must obtain an entry permit. Entry permit must be obtained on the visitor's behalf by a person legally resident in the area. Holders of such entry permits will be entitled to receive visas on arrival in Abu Dhabi.

Emirate of Dubai

- → Valid Passport
- Visitor visa valid for a period of 7 days only. Longer than 7 days must either hold a valid visa issued by a United Arab Emirates Embassy or an entry permit obtained on their behalf.

Emirate of Fujairah

- → Valid Passport
- → Visitor <u>visa</u> valid for a period of 7 days only. This visa must be sponsored by a person legally resident in Fujairah.

Emirate of Ras Al Khaimah

- → Valid Passport
- → Visitor <u>visa</u> valid for a period of 15 days only. This visa must be sponsored by a person legally resident in Ras Al Khaimah.

Emirate of Sharjah

- → Valid Passport
- → Transit <u>visa</u> valid for a period of 7 days; sponsor should be available at airport with valid passport. Visitor Visa for longer than 7 days.

Pilots – Same as passengers.

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Emirate of Fujairah

- → 3 General Declarations (2 Customs, 1 Immigration)
- → 2 Passenger Manifest (1 Customs, 1 Immigration,)
- → 2 Cargo Manifest (1Customs, 1 Police Security).

Emirate of Ras Al Kaimah

- → 3 General Declarations (1 Customs, 1 Health, 1 Immigration)
- → 2 Passenger Manifest (1 Customs, 1 Immigration,)
- → 1 Cargo Manifest (1Customs).

Emirate of Sharjah

- → 3 General Declarations (1 Customs, 1 Immigration, 1 Health)
- → 3 Passenger Manifest (1 Customs, 1 Immigration,)
- → 2 Cargo Manifest (1Customs, 1 Police Security).

Exit Requirements (Departing United Arab Emirates)

- → Same documents as required for entry (see Aircraft above)
- → Depart from an AOE
- → File <u>eAPIS</u> manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry
- → All passengers must complete an embarkation card

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. aircraft airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other countries requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meet those requirements.

The items listed below are for pilots' reference to determine if the aircraft meets minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

All IFR flights must carry Mode A, 4096 codes, and Mode C transponder.

Aircraft operating within the EMIRATES FIR shall carry sufficient instruments, equipment and flight documents to meet the applicable minimum requirements specified in ICAO Annex 6, Operation of Aircraft (Part I, II).

The requirements for the carriage of communications, navigation and approach aid equipment applicable to all aircraft flying in the Emirates Flight Information Region are laid down in United Arab Emirates Civil Aviation Regulations, Part 3, 4 and 5. Contact the General Civil Aviation authority (see Designated authorities) for purchase of the UAE regulations.

Aircraft operating above 10500 FT within the EMIRATES FIR, within RNAV 5 holding patterns and the DUBAI CTA and FUJAIRAH CTA shall carry valid documentation issued by the state of registry certifying that the aircraft carries equipment that meets or exceeds RNAV 5 requirements.

Turbine engine aeroplanes with a maximum certificated take - off mass in excess of 5700 KG or authorised to carry more than 19 passengers operated within the EMIRATES FIR shall carry serviceable Airborne Collision Avoidance System (ACAS II).

Aircraft operating to/from the territory of the UAE have to carry a copy of the insurance certificate.

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop / Overflight

Aircraft registered in ICAO states may overfly, or make non - traffic stops in Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Ras Al Khaimah and Fujairah without prior permission. Operators intending to

land in Abu Dhabi must include the intended duration of stay in item 18 of the ICAO flight plan.

Aircraft registered in states which are signatories to the ICAO Convention shall obtain permission for landing in the territory of Sharjah.

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

For permission to carry out such operations, operators should give at least two clear working days notice before the intended date of arrival or departure. The application must be accompanied by an international prepaid reply coupon and must include information specified by the AIP.

Operators intending to carry out non-scheduled flights for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers, cargo or mail, shall apply to:

- → The Territory of Abu Dhabi Airport Management
- → The Emirate of Fujairah The Chairman, Department of Civil Aviation
- → The Territory of Ras Al Khaimah The Chairman, Department of Civil Aviaiton
- → The Emirate of Sharjah The Director General of Civil Aviation
- → The Territory of Dubai The Director General, Dubai Civil Aviation Authority

Private Flights

<u>Emirate of Abu Dhabi</u> - The information contained in the flight plan is accepted as adequate advance information provided it will be received at least two (2) hours in advance of the arrival. The intended duration of stay is required in item 18of the ICAO flight plan.

Emirate of Dubai - The information contained in the flight plan is accepted as adequate advance information provided it will be received at least twenty four (24) hours in advance of the arrival. The intended duration of stay is required in item 18 of the ICAO flight plan.

Emirate of Fujairah – Same as for unscheduled non-traffic operations.

Emirate of Ras Al Khaimah - Same as for unscheduled non-traffic operations.

Emirate of Sharjah - Same as for unscheduled non-traffic operations.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for landing, parking, storage, passenger services, security and noise related items. Contact the appropriate authority of the destination airport.

Fuel

Jet A1 and Avgas are available at OMDB, OMAD, OMAA, OMAL, OMSJ and OMFJ. Jet A1 is available at OMRK and OMDW

Night VFR

VFR flights between the times of sunset and sunrise shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions specified by the GENERAL CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY.

Island Hopping
