Flight Information

The accuracy and currency of information contained in this guide is uncertain due to the difficulty in obtaining the information and the rapidly changing environment. Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

Airports of Entry

TBPB Bridgetown (Grantley Adams)

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

The CARICOM Implementation Agency for Crime and Security (IMPACS) requires that all private (including Part 91) and commercial flights to or from Barbados submit advance passenger information (APIS) prior to arrival or departure.

Aircraft landing in, or departing from the territory of Barbados must land at or depart from Grantley Adams International Airport.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

File an <u>eAPIS</u> manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too) File and activate international flight plan Land at Grantley Adams International Airport

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Valid passport
- → Visa for some countries (not required for USA)
- → Embarkation / Disembarkation Card

Pilots – Crew members are subjected to cursory checks against the incoming aircraft's General Declaration.

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft - 4 General Declarations; 1 for Health, 1 for Immigration, 2 for Customs

Exit Requirements (Departing Barbados)

- → Depart from an AOE
- → 2 General Declarations 1 for Immigration, 1 for customs
- → File eAPIS manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other country requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meets those requirements.

The items listed below are for the pilot's reference to determine if the aircraft meets the minimum instrument and equipment requirements, of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements

Commercial air transport and General Aviation operating in Barbados must adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 for the type of operation as indicated below:

Commercial	Part 1 Chapter 6	Part 1, Chapter 7
General Aviation	Part II, Chapter 6	Part II, Chapter 7

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop / Overflight

If an operator intends to operate a non-scheduled flight in transit non-stop across the territory of Barbados or in airspace not over the territory of Barbados but falling under the control of Barbados, or into Barbados for non-traffic purposes, he may do so without the necessity of obtaining the permission. However, the operator is required to notify the Adams air traffic least seventy two (72) hours prior to such operation.

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

Non-scheduled flights for commercial purposes may only be operated into or out of Barbados under, and in accordance with a permit granted by the Permanent Secretary. Applications must be submitted to the Civil Aviation authority at least ten working days prior to the date of planned operations.

Private Flights

The information contained in the flight plan is accepted as adequate advance notification of the arrival of incoming aircraft.

Float Planes

The IFIM staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft (LSA)

The IFIM staff is not aware of any LSA requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for parking, passenger service and security fees. The IFIM staff is not aware of any air navigation fees. Contact the Civil Aviation authority for further information.

Fuel

Jet A1 and Avgas are available at Grantley Adams International. Check with airport authority for hours of availability.

VFR / Night VFR

VFR flights shall not be operated:

- → Above FL 085
- → At transonic and supersonic speeds.

VFR flights may operate between sunset and sunrise with ATC authority with conditions.

Island Hopping

Each Island in the Caribbean may be its own sovereign nation. Please refer to specific country information prior to flying to other islands within the Caribbean.

Country Specific Travel Information

Public Health Requirements

Aircraft – All aircraft arriving in Barbados are to be disinfected. This action must be properly recorded in the health section of the General Declaration. Pilots should refer to the DOT website below for any current requirements.

DOT: Aircraft Disinsection Requirements

Passengers – A pilot or captain should radio ahead to the Airport Authority where a case of unusual sickness occurs onboard.

Immunizations: passengers may be required to present vaccination certificates in special cases.

No animal or bird shall be imported into the island of Barbados except in accordance with the terms of a permit granted by the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Fisheries. The laws of Barbados do not permit the importation of dogs and cats from the United States of America, Canada or any country where rabies occur unless the animal is first quarantine in Great Britain for six months and then imported directly by an approved route.
