Flight Information

The accuracy and currency of information contained in this guide is uncertain due to the difficulty in obtaining the information and the rapidly changing environment. Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Flight Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

- → General Declaration
- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at *IFIM Home>General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents*. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an eAPIS manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Valid passport
- → <u>Visa</u> for some countries (not required for USA up to 90 day visit)

Pilots - Same as passengers

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft -

No Information

Exit Requirements (Departing Bulgaria)

- → Depart from an AOE
- → File <u>eAPIS</u> manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

All aircraft operating in the airspace of the Republic of Bulgaria shall adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 and Annex 8.

The items listed below are for pilots' reference to determine if the aircraft meets minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

- → VHF two-way radios with 25 khz spacing (8.33 khz spacing above FL195)
- → SSR Transponder Mode C
- → RNAV 5
- → VOR/DME
- → ACAS (turbine engine with MTOGW over 5700 kg or more than 19 passengers)

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop / Overflight

Authorization for overflights through the airspace of the Republic of Bulgaria must be obtained not later than 5 (five) working days before the day of operation.

The applicant shall be informed of the granted flight clearances not later than 24 (twenty four) hours before the beginning of the flight.

A flight plan must be filed not later than 1 hour before the beginning of the flight to the following addresses:

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

See Technical Stop/Overflight

A flight clearance for non-scheduled international flights is granted by the CAA after submission by the applicant of the relevant information required. The required advance time of submission, of the required information, varies depending on the number of flights to be conducted. See the on-line Bulgaria AIP for details.

Private Flights

Only flight plans are required for private flights to Bulgaria.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for landing, parking, passengers, use of air bridge, security, noise and air navigation. See the on-line Bulgarian AIP for details.

Fuel

All of the AOEs have Jet A1 and Avgas except for LBPD – Plovdiv, which only offers Jet A1.

VFR/Night VFR

The visual flight rules between sunset and sunrise shall be operated only for take off, landing and flights within the traffic pattern.

Enroute VFR shall not be operated above FL200 or at transonic or supersonic speeds.

Island Hopping

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Island Hopping requirements or restrictions

Public Health Requirements

Aircraft – The pilot-in-command or a duly authorized representative, shall fill in and submit to the frontier health authorities the General Declaration of the aircraft upon arrival at the airport of destination

.Pilots should refer to the DOT website below for any current requirements.

DOT: Aircraft Disinsection Requirements

Passengers – All persons subjected to a sanitary border inspection are required to present international Certificate of Vaccination, issued according to the terms and conditions, prescribed by the World Health Organization.
