Flight Information

The accuracy and currency of information contained in this guide is uncertain due to the difficulty in obtaining the information and the rapidly changing environment. Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

Airports of Entry

WBSB Brunei International Airport

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to

Technical Stop section in **Additional Flight Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

- → General Declaration
- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- > Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at <u>IFIM Home>General Information>International</u> <u>Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents</u>. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an <u>eAPIS</u> manifest outbound (recommend filing inbound at this time)
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Valid passport (valid for at least 6 months)
- → Visa (for visits longer than for U.S. citizens)
- → Yellow Fever Certificate Persons over one year of age coming from infected area in last 6 days

Note: All applications for visa should be submitted through the Brunei Darussalam's Foreign Missions or Representatives of other governments who are performing consular functions on behalf of the Government of Brunei Darussalam.

Pilots - Same as passengers

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft -

- → General Declaration 1 for Airport Health Officer, 1 for Customs
- → Passenger Manifest 1 for Airport Health Officer, 1 for Customs

Exit Requirements (Departing Brunei)

- → Depart from an AOE
- → File <u>eAPIS</u> manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. aircraft airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other countries requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meet those requirements.

The items listed below are for pilots' reference to determine if the aircraft meets minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

Mode C Transponder

Commercial air transport aircraft operating in Negara Brunei Darussalam must adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 –Operation of Aircraft, Part 1 – International Commercial Air Transport – Airplanes, Chapter 6 (Airplane Instruments, Equipment and Flight Documents) and Chapter 7 (Airplane Communication and Navigation Equipment).

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop / Overflight

Prior permission is not required for overflight or non-traffic landings (technical stop) with respect to *non-scheduled flights (charters)*. Advance notification by flight plan to Brunei Aeronautical Information Service (WBSBYOYX) should ne received at least 2 hours prior to departure. Permits are required for all *revenue* non-scheduled flights.

There are varying fess for landing, special landing permits (for aircraft under 2500 kg), hangarage, long term storage and parking. There are no stated charges for air navigation in the AIP.

Fuel

Jet A1, only, is available at WBSB.

Night VFR/VFR

All flights shall be conducted in accordance with IFR during the hours between sunset and sunrise.

Procedures for Visual Flight Rules flight within the airspace of Brunei Darussalam are in conformity with Annexes 2 and 11 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, those portions of the Procedures for Air Navigation Services – Rules of the Air and Air Traffic Services applicable to aircraft and the Regional Supplementary Procedures (Doc 7030/3, Part 1). (see exceptions Gen 1.7-1)
