Flight Information

The accuracy and currency of information contained in this guide is uncertain due to the difficulty in obtaining the information and the rapidly changing environment. Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

Airports of Entry

FKKD	DOUALA
FKKR	GAROUA (On request)
FKYS	YAOUNDÉ/Nsimalen

Note: These AOE airports are normally limited to scheduled air carriers but permission for landing may be requested from the Civil Aviation authority.

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Flight Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents (where required):

- General Declaration
- Passenger Manifest
- Cargo Manifest
- Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at [/IFIM Home>General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents](#). The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- File an [eAPIS](#) manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- File and activate international flight plan
- Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) – customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers –

- Valid passport
- [Visa](#)
- Yellow Fever vaccination certificate

Pilots – Same as passengers

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft –

- General Declaration – 1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Public Health
- Passenger manifest – 1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Public Health
- Cargo manifest – 1 for Customs
- General declaration Health section indicating aircraft sprayed 30 minutes prior to arrival

Exit Requirements (Departing Cameroon)

- Same documents as required for entry (see Aircraft above)
- Depart from an AOE
- File [eAPIS](#) manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- File an international flight plan
- Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. aircraft airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other countries requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meet those requirements.

The items listed below are for pilots' reference to determine if the aircraft meets minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

- VHF and HF communication and navigation equipment suitable for the route and landing

Note: If equipped with TCAS, ACAS or transponder, must comply with ICAO standards

Commercial air transport aircraft operating in the member states of ASECNA must be complied with the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 -Operation of aircraft, Part 1- International Commercial Air Transport-Aircraft, Chapter 6 (Aircraft instruments, Equipment and Flight Documents) and Chapter 7 (Airplane Communication and Navigation Equipment).

All aircraft assigned to fly over an inhospitable region must be provided with special facilities including signaling, emergency and survival equipment and the manuals to operate such equipment. **The requirements for flight over inhospitable regions are extensive and too numerous to list. One should reference the free on-line AIP for details.**

RVSM

Technical Stop / Overflight

It is necessary for the operator/pilot to obtain prior permission, via application, from the Civil Aviation Authority and Air Force. (see Designated Authorities) The appropriate

military services shall issue a clearance to civil aircraft, on the recommendation of the Civil Aviation Authority

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

Same requirements as Technical Stop/Overflight.

Private Flights

Same requirements as Technical Stop/Overflight.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions (where applicable).

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions (where applicable).

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for air navigation landing, runway lighting, passenger services, overtime, parking, hangarage, fuel surcharge, passenger tax, security and Infrastructure fees. Please refer to the free on-line Ascena-Cameroon AIP for details.

Fuel

Jet A1 and Avgas are available at FKKD. FKKR and FKYS only offer Jet A1.

VFR/Night VFR

The VFR flights are not allowed over and above the flight level 150.

VFR flights are not authorized at night, which means, during the period that begins 15 minutes after the sunset and finishes 15 minutes before the sunrise.

Island Hopping

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Island Hopping requirements or restrictions.
