Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Flight Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

→ General Declaration

- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at <u>IFIM Home>General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents</u>. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an eAPIS manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- > File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Valid passport
- → Visa
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card

Pilots – Same as passengers

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft -

- → 3 General Declarations (1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Health)
- → 3 Passenger Manifests (1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Health)
- → 3 Cargo Manifests (1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Health)

Exit Requirements (Departing India)

- → Same documents as required for Entry (see *Aircraft* above)
- → Depart from an AOE
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → File <u>eAPIS</u> manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. aircraft airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other countries requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meet those requirements.

The items listed below are for pilots' reference to determine if the aircraft meets minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop / Overflight

Application for permission to conduct technical stops or overflights must be obtained three days prior to the scheduled flight.

Note: No prior permission is required for aircraft operating outside the Indian Territory which includes territorial waters but within Indian Flight Information Regions.

Overflying aircraft must carry with them the authorizing reference number of such AFTN signal authorizing the flight. Aircraft unable to quote the number are liable to make a landing in India.

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

If an operator intends to carry out a series of non-schedules flights the operator must apply prior approval of the DGCA. Application for operating non-scheduled flights(s) must be submitted at least 7 working days.

An AFTN signal authorizing such flights is issued by DGCA. The authorizing reference number shall be quoted in field 18 of the flight plan. The PIC is also required to carry the reference number with him and quote it when required by ATC.

A flight clearance shall be valid for a period of 48 hours. If a flight gets delayed beyond 48 hours, it will require fresh clearance from the DGCA.

Private Flights

Same requirements as those for non-scheduled flights.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Fuel

Jet A1 is available at all AOE's.

AvGas is limited. Verify availability with appropriate airport authority.

Night VFR

VFR flights shall not be operated between sunset and sunrise, except when exempted by air traffic control for local flights.

Island Hopping

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Island Hopping requirements or restrictions.

Country Specific Travel Information

Public Health Requirements

Aircraft – Aircraft shall have been disinfected at the commencement of the journey as per Aircraft (Public Health) Rules, 1954 and in accordance with Schedule IV of the said rules or the procedure recommended by the World Health Organization.

Pilots should refer to the DOT website below for any current requirements.

DOT: Aircraft Disinsection Requirements

Passengers – All passengers coming from yellow fever infected areas shall be in possession of a valid international certificate against yellow fever.

The PIC shall send a radio message hours before arrival about the state of health of any person on board who has visited a yellow fever infected area within the previous six days and who is not in possession of a valid yellow fever certificate.
