Flight Information

The accuracy and currency of information contained in this guide is uncertain due to the difficulty in obtaining the information and the rapidly changing environment. Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

VDSR	Siem Reap International Airport
VDSV	Sihanouk International Airport (on request)

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Flight Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

- → General Declaration
- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents">ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an <u>eAPIS</u> manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Valid passport
- → Visa

Pilots - Same as passengers

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft -

- → General Declaration 1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Public Health
- → Passenger Manifest 1 for Customs,1 for Immigration, 1 for Public Health
- → Cargo Manifest 1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration
- → Aircraft insurance documents

Exit Requirements (Departing Cambodia)

Same documents as required for Entry (see Aircraft- above)
Depart from an AOE

- → File <u>eAPIS</u> manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- > File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry
- → General Declaration 1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration, 1 for Public Health
- → Passenger Manifest 1 for Immigration, 1 for Public Health
- → Cargo Manifest 1 for Customs, 1 for Immigration

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. aircraft airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other countries requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meet those requirements.

The items listed below are for pilots' reference to determine if the aircraft meets minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

Commercial air transport aircraft operating in Cambodia must adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 Operation of Aircraft, Part 1- International Commercial Air Transport Airplanes, Chapter 6 (Airplane Instruments, Equipment and Flight Documents) and Chapter 7 (Aeroplane Communication and Navigation Equipment).

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop / Overflight

Flights into or over Cambodia airspace must comply with the Standards and Recommended Practices contained in ICAO Annex 9,

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

Non-scheduled commercial flights should apply for permission to operate at least 15 working days prior to the flight. Application should be made to the Secretariat of Civil Aviation Authority (see Designated Authorities).

All requests must include the following information in the order shown:

- > Name, address and nationality of owner.
- > Nationality, type and registration marks of aircraft and call sign to be used
- → Name of pilot and crew
- → Purpose of flight
- → Complete route of flight from origin to final destination
- > Names and nationalities of passengers
- → Type and amount of cargo

Additionally, prior permission must be obtained independently from SSCA (State Secretariat of Civil Aviation), Flight Operations Department.

Private Flights

Private flights should apply for permission to operate at least 15 working days prior to the flight. Application should be made to the Civil Aviation Authority (see Designated Authorities).

All requests must include the following information in the order shown:

- → Name, address and nationality of owner.
- > Nationality, type and registration marks of aircraft and call sign to be used
- > Name of pilot and crew
- → Purpose of flight
- → Complete route of flight from origin to final destination
- → Names and nationalities of passengers
- > Type and amount of cargo

Additionally, prior permission must be obtained independently from SSCA (State Secretariat of Civil Aviation), Flight Operations Department.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for landing, parking, lighting, passenger services, ground handling, weekend and holiday surcharges. Air navigation charges will also apply to overflights and landings.

Fuel

Jet A1 is the only type of fuel available at Phnom Pehn and Siem Reap airports. Jet A1 is available at Sihanouk but must be ordered at least 3 days in advance.

Night VFR/VFR

Night VFR flights between sunset and sunrise are not authorized.

VFR flights shall not operate above FL150 or at transonic/supersonic speeds. All VFR flights outside controlled airspace are required to monitor 127.5 MHz

Island Hopping

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Island Hopping requirements or restrictions.
