Flight Information

The accuracy and currency of information contained in this guide is uncertain due to the difficulty in obtaining the information and the rapidly changing environment. Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

Airports of Entry

GLRB Roberts International Airport

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

- → General Declaration
- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents">ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Prior to departure pilots must ensure they are complying with and meet the entry requirements for the destination country.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an eAPIS manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Passport
- → Visa required for U.S. Citizens
- > ICAO Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Yellow Fever vaccination certificate

Crew as you should be—Same as passengers

Note: Other requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight

Note: If no passengers are embarking (or disembarking) and no articles are laden (unladen), only the General Declaration is required to be distributed as above.

Exit Requirements (Departing Liberia)

- → Depart from an AOE
- → File eAPIS manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other country requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meets those requirements.

The items listed below are for the pilot's reference to determine if the aircraft meets the minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

Commercial air transport aircraft operating in Liberia must adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 – Operation of Aircraft, Part 1 – International Commercial Air Transport – Aeroplanes, Chapter 6 (Aeroplanes Instruments, Equipment and Flight Documents) and Chapter 7 (Aeroplane Communication and Navigation Equipment).

Additional relevant information is contained in the Liberia Civil Aviation Regulation (LCAR) Part 7.1.1.4. Contact the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority for details.

Due to the difficult nature of the terrain, signaling and survival equipment is recommended.

RVSM

Technical Stop/Overflight

Non-scheduled Flights:

If an operator intends to carry out a non-scheduled flight or series of non-scheduled flights in transit across Liberia, he may do so by obtaining permission at least 72 hours in advance to:

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

If an operator intends to perform a (or series of) non scheduled flights for the purpose of taking or discharging passengers, cargo or mail. It is necessary for the operator to apply for permission not less than 72 hours in advance to:

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for landing, parking (free up to 6 hours), hangarage, storage, passenger services (departure tax \$25.00), cargo handling, security, after hour surcharges and air navigation. Fees may be payable by the operator or pilot on demand.

Fuel

Jet A1 available at GLRB.

Night VFR/VFR

Night VFR flights are not permitted within the Roberts Control Zone. Day VFR is permitted in an established "Light Aircraft Corridor".

Aeronautical Charts

Aeronautical charts may be obtained from the AIS office (see Aeronautical Information Services listed under Designated Authorities).

Public Health Requirements

Passengers – Passengers leaving Liberia are required to present a yellow fever vaccination certificate. Any passenger not vaccinated against yellow fever will not be allowed to enter or depart the Republic of Liberia. The same formalities are required for arrival.
