Flight Information

Aviators should always check with a country's aviation authority or a local aviation handler to determine any specific aircraft airworthiness/equipment and crew/passenger entry requirements.

Note: Except as noted, all of the above airports are available only to scheduled and private flights.

Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry and Exit documentation forms vary from country to country. In general, however, ICAO member countries will accept the following standard ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit documents:

- → General Declaration
- → Passenger Manifest
- → Cargo Manifest
- → Embarkation/Disembarkation Card
- → Certificate of Residual Disinsection

Examples of these documents can be found at General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents">IFIM Home>General Information>International Flying Overview> ICAO Annex 9 Entry/Exit Documents. The acceptance of these ICAO documents must be confirmed by the appropriate AIS.

Entry Requirements (Departing the U.S.)

- → File an eAPIS manifest outbound (recommend inbound at this time, too)
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at a designated airport of entry (AOE) customs and immigration

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Passport
- → Visa required for U.S. citizens
- → Vaccination Certificate only required if coming from cholera, yellow fever or smallpox infected area.

Crew - Same as passengers

Note: Other requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight

Aircraft -

- → General Declaration 1 for Airport authorities, 1 for Customs, 1 for Passport Control
- → Passenger Manifest 1 for Airport authorities, 1 for Passport Control
- → Cargo Manifest 1 for Airport authorities, 1 for Customs

Exit Requirements (Departing Mozambique)

- → Same documents as required for Entry (see *Aircraft* above)
- → Depart from an AOE
- → File eAPIS manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- > File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other country requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meets those requirements.

The items listed below are for the pilot's reference to determine if the aircraft meets the minimum instrument and equipment requirements of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

Commercial air transport aircraft operating in Mozambique must adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 – Operation of Aircraft, Part 1 – International Commercial Air Transport – Airplanes, Chapter 6 (Airplanes Instruments, Equipment and Flight Documents) and Chapter 7 (Airplane Communication and Navigation Equipment)

General Aviation aircraft operating in Mozambique must adhere to the provisions of Annex 6-Part III - International General Aviation - Airplanes, Chapter 6 and 7.

The following radio and navigation equipment shall be carried within Beira FIR:

- → One ADF
- → Appropriate VHF RTF frequencies
- → VOR for IFR flights

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop/Overflight

Prior permission is *not* required for overflights or non-traffic stops.

Non-scheduled Flights (Charters)

If an operator intends to perform a (series) of non-scheduled charter flight(s) it is necessary to apply to the Civil Aviation Authority (see Designated Authorities) not less than 24 hours in advance of the landing.

Private Flights

Prior permission is *not* required for private flights landing in Mozambique.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for landing, landing outside of published hours, parking, passenger service (departure tax), cargo services, housing service, aircraft handling, refueling surcharge, provisioning services and air navigation.

Fuel

All of the AOEs offer Jet A1 and Avgas except for FQQL which only has Jet A1.

VFR/Night VFR

VFR - shall not be operated above FL145 or at transonic or supersonic speeds

Night VFR - flights between sunset and sunrise or such other period between sunset and sunrise as may be prescribed by the director, shall be operated in accordance with the conditions prescribed by the director.
