Entry/Exit Requirements

Entry and exit requirements are for aircraft departing the United States non-stop to country of destination. These requirements do not include any technical stops. Please refer to **Technical Stop** section in **Additional Information** for the country at which the technical stop will be made.

Entry Requirements (Departing U.S.)

- → File an eAPIS manifest outbound
- → File and activate international flight plan
- → Land at an AOE

The following entry documents are required:

Passengers -

- → Valid passport
- → Visa for stays longer than 3 months

Pilots - Same as passengers

Note: Other pilot/crewmember requirements may be applicable in lieu of those stated. Contact appropriate AIS for further clarification prior to flight.

Aircraft -

- → Non-scheduled Commercial flights Cargo Manifest 2 copies
- → Private flights Log book or Cargo Manifest 2 copies

Exit Requirements (Departing Norway)

- → Same documents as required for Entry (see *Aircraft* above)
- → Depart from an AOE
- → File eAPIS manifest if inbound to the U.S.
- → File an international flight plan
- → Call U.S. Customs at filed U.S. airport of entry

Additional Flight Information

Aircraft Instruments and Equipment

U.S. airworthiness and certification requirements may not meet other country requirements. It is the responsibility of the pilot to determine if the aircraft meets those requirements.

The items listed below are for the pilot's reference to determine if the aircraft meets the minimum instrument and equipment requirements, of the destination country. Additional equipment may be required to comply with the airspace navigation requirements.

Radio navigation equipment

- → ADF (IFR, Class C & D airspace)
- → VOR(IFR, Class C & D airspace)
- → DME (IFR, Class C & D airspace)
- → Mode C Transponder
- → RNAV (IFR above FL95)
- → RNAV (IFR above 5000 MSL in Oslo Terminal Control Area)

Radio communication equipment

→ VHF 2-way radio (8.33 kHz spacing above FL195)

RVSM

<u>Domestic and International RVSM</u> guidance is provided on the IFIM Home Page. Click on the **Air Traffic** tab and select **Separation Standards** from the drop down list.

Technical Stop/Overflight

No prior permission is required for Technical Stops or Overflight.

Non-scheduled Commercial Flights (Charters)

Prior permission must be obtained from the Civil Aviation Authority for commercial stops in Norway.

Flight plans must reach the Norway ATC at least 4 hours before entering their airspace.

Private Flights

Flight plans must reach the Norway ATC at least 60 minutes before entering their airspace. Prior permission is not required.

Float Planes

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Float Plane requirements or restrictions.

Light Sport Aircraft

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Light Sport Aircraft requirements or restrictions.

Fees

Users should anticipate varying fees for landing, parking, hangarage, passenger services, security and noise related items. Contact Airport Charges and Fees authority listed in Designated Authorities.

Fuel

All of the entry airports have Jet A1 and Avgas except for ENHD, ENRY, and ENNK which do not offer AvGas.

VFR Flight

VFR flight is not permitted above FL290.

Night VFR

The IFIM staff is not aware of any restrictions or regulations.

Island Hopping

The IFIM Staff is not aware of any Island Hopping requirements or restrictions.

Public Health Requirements

Aircraft – There is no information available in the current AIP regarding public health actions for aircraft. Please refer to the DOT website below for any current requirements.

DOT: <u>Aircraft Disinsection Requirements</u>

Passengers – The pilot-in-command shall, before landing, report by radio to the Air Traffic Control unit concerned, cases of illness of a contagious nature which have occurred during flight. Under such circumstances, crew members and passengers are allowed to leave the aircraft only upon special permission from the local airport authority.
