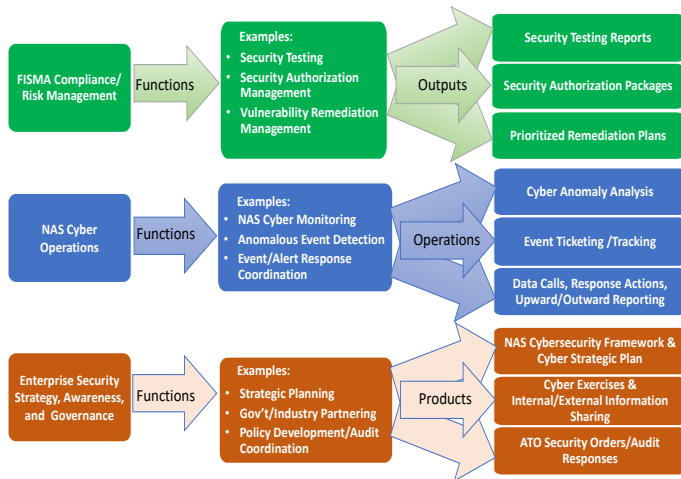
Secure ATO systems and services from existing and evolving cybersecurity threats.

The ATO Cybersecurity Group is made up of five Teams that work cohesively to perform cyber security functions as an enterprise service to the Air Traffic Organization (ATO).

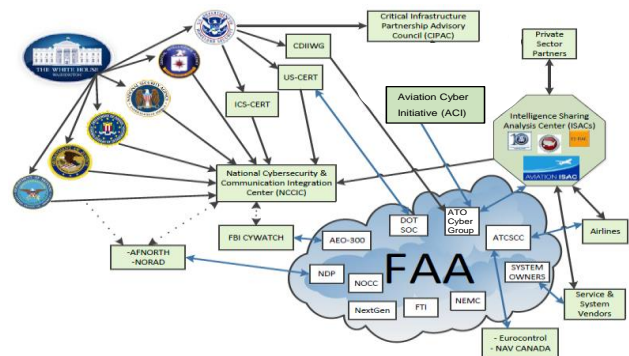
Functional Overview
