1. Applicant sends application to geographic ACO with applicable data as noted under ACO Responsibilities #2		
ACO Responsibilities		
1. ACO cover letter on behalf of applicant (<i>Not necessary but helpful to track receipt and provide POC to DCA</i>)		Use Memo 08-03 Appendix 1 pages 1 and 2 on AIR-40 website
2. For TCs, ensure applicant's data package includes supporting documentation necessary to satisfy 14 CFR pt 21, subpart L and Appendix 1 of DCA Airworthiness Notice No.1, <i>Certification of Aircraft</i>	3.0.2(a)	http://www.dca.gov.my/Division/Airworthiness/Airworthiness_notices.html
3. Coordinate with DCA to establish the supporting documentation

1. After receipt of application package from FAA, DCA notifies FAA of the acceptance of application or if incomplete, communicate what is deficient or missing (<i>Not necessary but helpful to provide</i>)		
2. DCA may apply some conditions before issuance in accordance with 14 CFR part 21, subpart H	3.0.2(b)	
Applicant Responsibilities		
1. Provide information (as necessary)		
ACO Responsibilities		
1. Communicate (as necessary) project status between DCA and applicant
