

UKRAINE – SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Revised – January 14, 2025

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 All civil aeronautical products (aircraft, engines, propellers, and articles) intended for use in Ukraine must meet design approval and export requirements of the State Aviation Administration of Ukraine (SAAU) regulations.
- 1.2 SAAU and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) have established a Working Procedure (WP) for the means by which design approvals and import requirements are to be processed in order to be eligible for import into Ukraine.

2. DESIGN APPROVALS

- 2.1 The type design of aviation products designed in United States (U.S.) and intended for import to Ukraine is validated by the SAAU, as the Ukrainian aviation authority, in accordance with WP for the Type Certification and Continued Airworthiness of Aircraft, Engines, and Propellers between Aviation Register, State Department of Aviation Transport of Ukraine, and Aircraft Certification Service, Federal Aviation Administration, Department of Transportation.
- 2.2 On the basis of such validation results, the SAAU issues a Ukrainian Type Certificate where the Special Requirements of Ukraine for aviation products intended to be operated and/or registered in Ukraine are stipulated.

3. EXPORT TO UKRAINE

- 3.1 All exporters shipping civil aeronautical products from the United States to Ukraine must comply with the SAAU–FAA WP. Compliance with SAAU–FAA WP Article IV meets the FAA regulatory requirements identified in 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart L.
- 3.2 Export Certificates of Airworthiness issued by FAA shall state satisfaction with such Special Requirements in 2.2.
