## **EUROPEAN UNION – SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

Revised – August 18, 2025

Provided by the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) and applicable to all European Union (EU) Member States.

## 1. PROCEDURE

- 1.1 All exporters shipping civil aircraft or articles from the United States to a Member State of the EU must comply with Section VII, Export Procedures, of the Technical Implementation Procedures (TIP) for Airworthiness and Environmental Certification Between the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) of the United States of America and the European Union Aviation Safety Agency, Revision 7, Amendment 1, or with the corresponding Section in later-approved revisions. Compliance with TIP Section 7 meets the regulatory requirements identified in 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart L. These EU special import requirements replace the previously published Special Requirements for aircraft or articles for all EU Member States.
