

CONFEDERATION OF SWITZERLAND - SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS
(Revised – October 5, 2022)

1. PROCEDURE

1.1 According to the IMPLEMENTATION PROCEDURE FOR DESIGN APPROVAL, PRODUCTION ACTIVITIES, EXPORT AIRWORTHINESS APPROVAL, POST DESIGN APPROVAL ACTIVITIES, AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE under the Agreement between The Government of Switzerland and The Government of the United States of America For Promotion of Aviation Safety revision 0, dated September 2, 2015, and Amendment 1 to revision 0, dated June 14, 2016, all exporters shipping civil aeronautical products or articles from the United States to Switzerland must comply with the provisions of Section VII in the Technical Implementation Procedures for Airworthiness and Environmental Certification between the FAA and EASA (TIP), as amended, under the United States and European Union Aviation Safety Agreement. Compliance with TIP Section VII meets the regulatory requirements identified in 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart L.
