The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), National Kit Evaluation Team Lead has completed a desk audit review of the Carbon Cub EX-3 (CCK-2000) kit. This kit is defined by Master Document List, for the Carbon Cub EX-3 Kit, Revision 1.0 dated December 27, 2018. It has been determined that the kit may allow an amateur builder to meet the major portion requirement of Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations part 21, Certification Procedures for Products and Parts, §21.191(g).

We will advise the Aircraft Certification Service Production and Airworthiness Division to add the kit to the Revised Listing of Amateur-Built Aircraft Kits (Kit List) located on the FAA website. This evaluation does not mean that the Carbon Cub EX-3 (CCK-2000) aircraft or Cub Crafters Inc. is FAA certified, certificated, or approved, and it is inappropriate to represent either as such.

CubCrafters Inc. should notify this office in writing if ownership of the company changes and/r if there are changes made to the evaluated kit that may affect its potential to meet the major portion requirement. Failure to notify this office may result in removal of the kit from the Kit List.
