The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) National Kit Evaluation Team has completed its evaluation of the "Onex" Standard and Finished Spar Option amateur-built aircraft kits. The team has determined that the standard Onex kit, defined by the Onex Pack List #ONX-KIT-112911, dated 11/29/11 and the Finished Spar Option kit defined by the Onex Pack List #ONX-KIT-ALL-112911, dated 11/29/11 may allow an amateur builder to meet the major portion requirement of Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations part 21, Certification Procedures for Products, Articles and Parts, § 21.191(g).

The Production and Airworthiness Division (AIR-200) will have the kits added to the Revised Listing of Amateur-Built Aircraft Kits located on the FAA website. This evaluation does not mean that the "Onex" kit or Sonex Aircraft, LLC is FAA *Certified*, *Certificated*, or *Approved*, and it is inappropriate to represent either as such.

Sonex Aircraft LLC should notify this office in writing if ownership of the company changes or if there are changes made to the evaluated kit. Failure to notify this office may result in removal of the kit from the List of Amateur-Built Aircraft Kits.
