Dear Mayor Mulder:

In our letter to you dated February 26, 2009, we made a commitment to provide you with data concerning nighttime operations on O'Hare Runway 9L/27R on a monthly basis.

During the month of October 2011, Runway 9L was used for ten arrivals and nine departures between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. During the same month, Runway 27R was not used between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

All of the operations on Runway 9L occurred on October 17 between the hours of 10:07 p.m. and 11:24 p.m. and on October 18 between the hours of 10:01 p.m. and 10:18 p.m., and were performed by a Federal Aviation Administration Flight Inspection (general aviation) aircraft. The aircraft flew several approaches and departures inspecting the electronic instrumentation for the runway. The inspections are required on a periodic basis and are performed overnight to minimize impacts to airport operations.
