Dear Mayor Mulder:

In our letter to you dated February 26, 2009, we made a commitment to provide you with data concerning nighttime operations on O'Hare Runway 9L/27R on a monthly basis.

During the month of February 2013, Runway 27R was used for sixteen arrivals and eight departures between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Due to weather and operational conditions on February 18, eight arrivals (commercial air carrier activity) occurred between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 10:13 p.m. Federal Aviation Administration Flight Inspection (general aviation) aircraft used the runway for eight arrivals and eight departures on February 28 between the hours 10:33 p.m. and 11:22 p.m. The aircraft flew several approaches and departures inspecting the electronic instrumentation on the runway. These inspections are required on a periodic basis and are performed overnight to minimize impacts to airport operations

There were no arrivals or departures on Runway 9L during nighttime hours in February.
