Dear Mr. Smithmeyer, Mr. Cooper and Mr. Roberts:


On behalf of the communities of Bensenville and Elk Grove Village, Illinois, the Religious Objectors and Roxanne Mitchell ("Objectors"), and in further support of their opposition to Chicago's request for an AIP discretionary grant and for a Letter of Intent, the undersigned hereby submit the affidavit of Robert H. Haveman, Professor Emeritus from the Department of Economics of the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Mr. Haveman's affidavit supports the findings and conclusions of the Campbell Hill Aviation Group Inc. in its study submitted on October 28, 2005 entitled: "The City of Chicago's Second Attempt To Justify The O'Hare Modernization Program Fails The FAA Benefit-Cost Requirements". Mr. Haveman's affidavit provides compelling evidence demonstrating that the City of Chicago's Benefit-Cost Analysis is flawed and fails to meet FAA BCA guidelines and established standards for benefit-cost studies.

Accordingly, the FAA should deny Chicago's applications for AIP discretionary grants and for a Letter of Intent.
