H.1 INTRODUCTION

Interim Fly Quiet Re-Evaluation

The FAA is currently conducting a Written Re-Evaluation of the O'Hare Modernization Environmental Impact Statement for an Interim Fly Quiet Runway Rotation Plan.

Since September 2015, the Fly Quiet Committee of the O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission (ONCC) has worked with the Chicago Department of Aviation (CDA), airlines, and the FAA to evaluate ways to improve the existing Fly Quiet Program to reduce noise concerns.

The ONCC oversaw three Fly Quiet Runway Rotation Plan tests to collect data on proposed runway configurations that could provide near-term relief to the highest impacted communities surrounding O'Hare. The results of all three tests can be found on the [CDA's Fly Quiet page](#). In December 2017, the ONCC recommended that the Test 3 be submitted to the FAA for an Interim Fly Quiet Runway Rotation Plan. The CDA submitted the [request](#) to the FAA in February 2018.

In the Interim Fly Quiet Re-Evaluation, the FAA will examine the potential effects of Interim Fly Quiet on key environmental aspects, including noise, air quality, and environmental justice. The FAA will release a Draft Interim Fly Quiet Re-Evaluation for review and comment. The FAA will hold public workshops in the communities surrounding O'Hare to give residents the opportunity to learn more about the proposed Interim Fly Quiet. Throughout the public process, the FAA will collect comments. These comments and the responses to them will be included in the Final Interim Fly Quiet Re-Evaluation. It is important to note that, if approved, the Interim Fly Quiet would be implemented soon after FAA approval through January 2021, when Runway 9R/27L is closed for extension construction. Runway construction, maintenance, and/or pavement rehabilitation will impact the Interim Fly Quiet during the 2019 and 2020 construction seasons. It is not anticipated that Interim Fly Quiet would occur during construction periods.

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H.3 PUBLIC WORKSHOPS AND DRAFT RE-EVALUATION COMMENT PERIOD

To provide the public with opportunities to comment on the Draft Re-Evaluation, the FAA will host four public workshops in neighborhoods surrounding O'Hare, as seen in **Exhibit 4-1**. The workshops will provide attendees with information about the Re-Evaluation and allow for submitting comments on the document via electronic and paper comment forms and orally through court reporters.

FAA issued public workshop dates, times, and locations on its website on January 3, 2019. FAA made the Draft Re-Evaluation available on its website on January 14, 2019. FAA also delivered paper or digital copies to 83 public libraries listed in **Table H-1**.

The period for submitting comments on the Draft Re-Evaluation began January 14, 2019, the day that the document was released to the public on FAA's website and at public libraries. The public comment period will end 45 days later, February 27, 2019. Comments received during this period, as well as FAA's responses to those comments, will be included in the Final Re-Evaluation.
