- Provide regional support functions to supplement the Planning and Engineering role
- Provide guidance and oversight for land acquisition
- Provide guidance and oversight of airfield pavement construction and maintenance
- Administers the State Block Grant Program for the state of Missouri
- Responsible for the region's on-airport obstruction analyses and evaluations
- Responsible for the environmental program
- Fiscal control of the region's Airport Improvement Program

- Responsible for processing requests for assistance under our airport development programs and formulating an annual assistance program.

- Airport planners develop the regional component of the National Plan of Integrated Airports System (NPIAS), which is utilized as the basic planning document to support the federal assistance programs. Planners provide planning guidance and advisory services for all airport-planning efforts (master plans, airport layout plans, system plans, etc.) and develop the region's Airports Improvement Program (AIP) recommendations.

Airport Engineers, Nardos Wills, Team Lead (816) 329-2636

- Airport engineers administer AIP development grants. AIP grant administration includes notification and coordination of grant provisions with the Sponsor, oversight of A/E contracting, pre-design meetings, concurrence in pavement design, plans and specifications review, concurrence in awards and notices to proceed, pre-construction conferences, periodic construction inspections, final inspections, payments and project closeouts. Oversee and advises on wildlife issues
