


# AIRPORT CERTIFICATION INFORMATION BULLETIN

**Runway Incursion Prevention**

Runway Incursions and Surface Incidents at Part 139 airports have risen quickly during fiscal year 2007. To date, the number of reported incursions exceeds last year's rate. 14 CFR 139.329 (b) states that each certificate holder must "Establish and implement procedures for the safe and orderly access to, and operation in, movement areas and safety areas by pedestrians and ground vehicles, including provisions identifying the consequences of noncompliance with the procedures by an employee, tenant, or contractor." Additionally 139.329 (e) references the training required.
