The NAS contains more than 2,300 non-Federally owned AWOS, NavAids, and other systems. We regulate their lifecycles, including installation, commissioning, operation, and decommissioning. We also oversee the non-Federally employed technicians who maintain those systems. Finally, a limited number of non-Federal facilities are eligible for takeover by the FAA, and we govern that process.

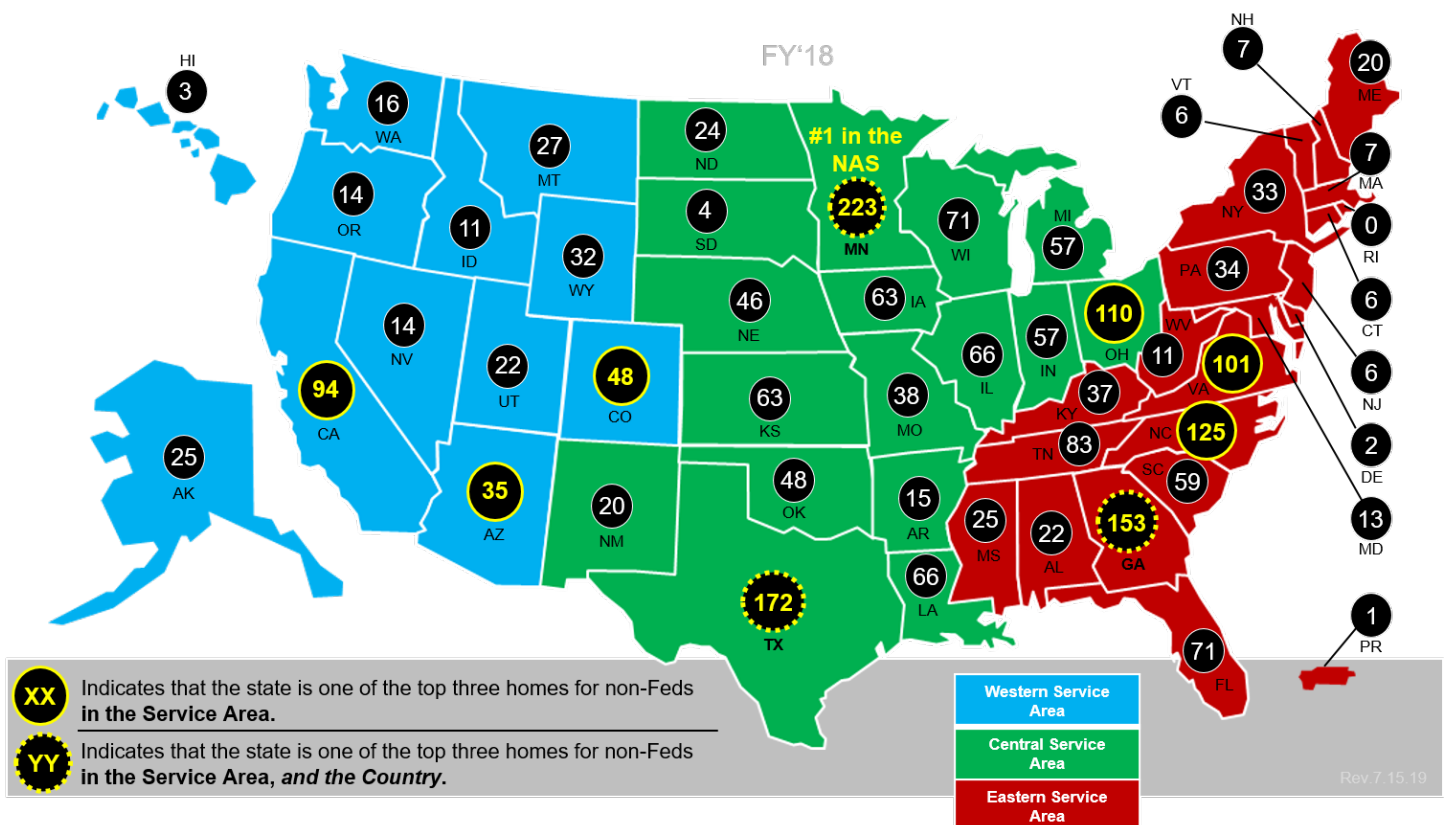
