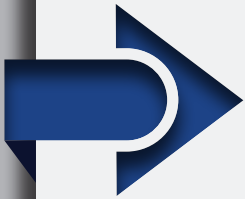


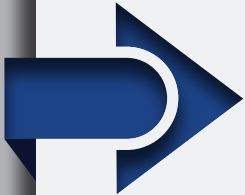


CONSTRUCTION NOTICE DIAGRAM



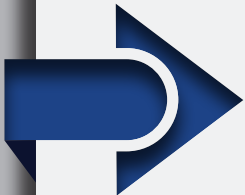
WHAT IS A CONSTRUCTION NOTICE DIAGRAM?

A Construction Notice Diagram (CND) is a visual depiction of runway and taxiway closures and restrictions during airport construction.



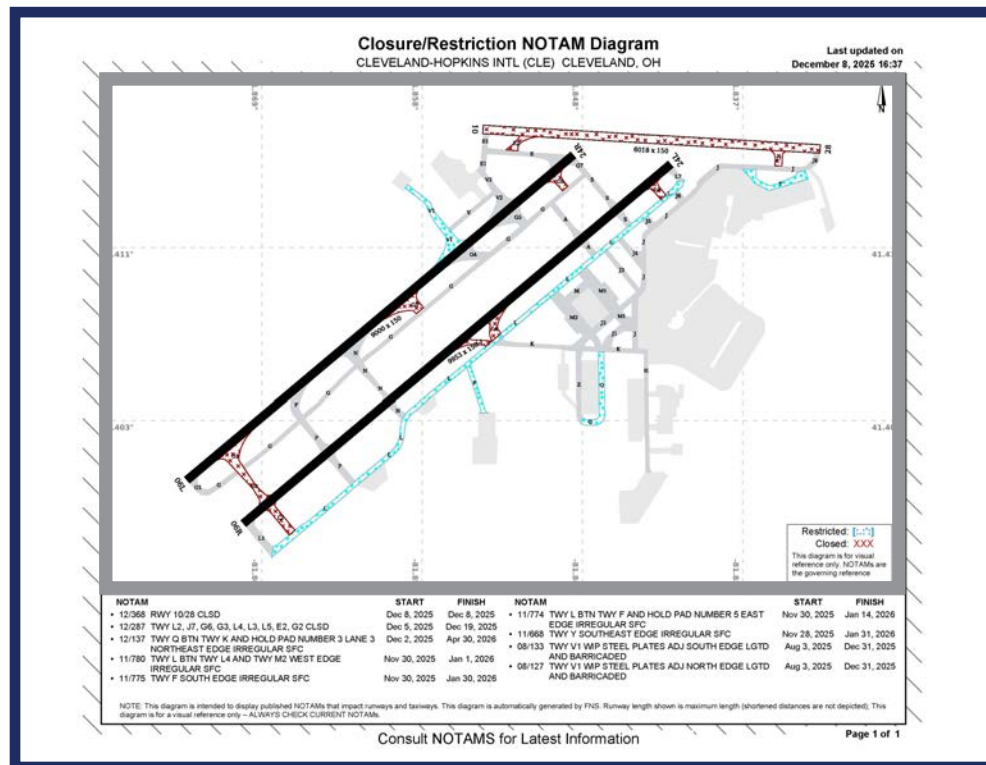
WHEN DO YOU USE A CND?

Pilots use a CND during pre-flight planning and for taxi awareness while on the airport surface.
