FAA adds public hearing on Las Vegas airport flight path plan

The public will get another chance to weigh in on the proposed changes to the flight path at McCarran International Airport.

The Federal Aviation Administration says it will hold a third and final public hearing on the controversial "right turn" plan on February 27th.

The change in the flight path would send departing planes over parts of the wealthy Summerlin and The Lakes neighborhoods.

Some residents there have strongly opposed the plan.

The meeting is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. at the Veterans Memorial Recreation Center. The public comment period already has been extended until March 14th.
