
WHEREAS, these proposed flights can also be a safety issue that could kill hundreds of residents from a plane crash within the Association.


WHEREAS, by a unanimous vote the Board of Directors for Sun City Summerlin Community Association wishes to preserve the quality of life and safety of its residents.


