


AIRPORT CERTIFICATION INFORMATION BULLETIN

Airport Condition Reporting

In our dynamic environment it is essential that all reported airport conditions be timely and accurate. This bulletin expands upon CERTALERT NO. 07-01 discussing the need for better dissemination of airfield conditions. Each certificated airport has an obligation under 14 CFR 139.339 to “provide for the collection and dissemination of airport condition information to air carriers.” With today’s wireless and web-based technologies, airports should consider implementation of real-time airport conditions to users. Some airports within our region have taken a proactive approach, using the internet in conjunction with the NOTAM system to provide broad and timely dissemination to their users.
