All others	<p>Submit the following to the FAA for review:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> A current, detailed Clinical Progress Note generated from a clinic visit with the treating oncologist no more than 90 days before the AME exam. It must include a detailed summary of the history of the condition, physical exam findings, results of any testing performed, diagnosis, assessment and plan, prognosis, and follow-up. <input type="checkbox"/> It must specifically include <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Initial staging; ○ Treatments used; ○ How long the condition has been stable or in remission; ○ Any term follow-up (surveillance) requirements; ○ Recurrence(s); ○ Risk of recurrence; and ○ If recurrence were to occur, how would it present <input type="checkbox"/> Medication list: Dates started and stopped. Description of side effects, if any; <input type="checkbox"/> Operative notes and discharge summary (if applicable); <input type="checkbox"/> Copies of lab including pathology reports, tumor markers (if already performed by treating physician); <input type="checkbox"/> Copies of imaging reports from testing already performed (such as MRI/CT or PET scan); and <input type="checkbox"/> Copies of any other testing already performed for this condition. 	<div></div> <p>DEFER</p> <p>Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance.</p> <p>Follow up Issuance Will be per the airman's authorization letter.</p>
