A CLL/SLL Status Summary (to expedite case processing); 2. A current, detailed Clinical Progress Note generated from a clinic visit with a board-certified ONCOLOGIST no more than 90 days before the AME exam. It must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A detailed summary of the history of the condition; • Current medications, dosage, and side effects (if any); • Physical exam findings; • Results of any testing performed; • Diagnosis; • Assessment and plan; • Prognosis based on Rai/Binet stage and other clinically indicated markers; and • Follow-up; | <p align="center">DEFER</p> <p>Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance</p> <p>Annotate (elements or findings) in Item 60.</p> |
