The FAA may request additional evaluation data.</p> <p>If uncertain, the AME may wish to contact AMCD or RFS and discuss.</p>	<p style="background-color: green; color: black; text-align: center; padding: 5px;">ISSUE</p> <p>and explain rationale in Item 60.</p>

AME determines the individual</p> <p>IS at increased risk</p> <p>for sudden or subtle incapacitation.</p>	<p>Medical certificates must not be issued to an individual with medical condition(s) that requires deferral, or for any condition not listed in the table that may result in sudden or subtle incapacitation without consulting the AMCD or the RFS.</p> <p>To help expedite the review process, submit the following to the FAA for review:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most recent detailed Clinical Progress Note(s) • Results of recent testing already performed pertinent to the condition • Any related treatment records <p>After reviewing this documentation, the FAA may request additional evaluation data.</p>	<p style="background-color: red; color: black; text-align: center; padding: 5px;">DEFER</p> <p>Upload copies of any documentation/reports to the FAA for review.</p> <p>Explain in Item 60 what aspect or concern caused the deferral.</p>
