A. Due to pituitary tumor	See Pituitary Adenoma page.	
B. Due to any other cause (e.g., adrenal insufficiency, hypothyroidism, medication, chronic kidney disease, or tumor in any location other than pituitary)	Submit the following for FAA review: 1. A current, detailed Clinical Progress Note generated from a clinic visit with their treating endocrinologist no more than 90 days before the AME exam. <i>It should include a summary of the history of the condition or diagnosis; current medications, dosages, and side effects (if any); clinical exam findings; results of any testing performed; diagnosis; assessment and plan (prognosis); and follow-up.</i> It must specifically include a discussion of the cause of the hyperprolactinemia, including any concern of a pituitary tumor. 2. Results of any other testing (e.g., labs or imaging) already performed. 3. Medical records from any visit associated with this condition. 4. If any concern for pituitary tumor, MRI pituitary must be submitted. See Pituitary Adenoma page for requirements.	DEFER Submit the information to the FAA for a possible Special Issuance.
